Can the AUC clarify that a Noise Impact Assessment and a Noise Impact Summary Form are not required to be filed if a proponent submitting a checklist application has completed the Noise Impact Assessment Flowchart and has determined that it meets the less than 3 dBA criteria? If a Noise Impact Summary Form is required to be submitted in place of a Noise Impact Assessment, should the flowchart reflect this necessary step?

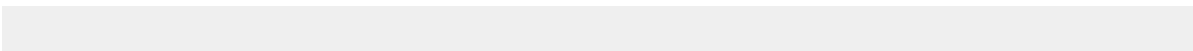

Initiation of stakeholder consultation process for AUC Rule 012: Noise Control

The Alberta Utilities Commission (AUC) is reviewing its rules with a focus on eliminating requirements that may have become outdated or unnecessary and is exploring opportunities to streamline and improve regulation and adjudicative processes.

The AUC regulates noise associated with electric and gas pipeline facilities. The AUC is initiating a written consultation process on potential changes to certain provisions of [Rule 012: Noise Control](#). Initial proposed changes to the rule have been identified by AUC staff and are divided into two major sections. The first section of changes have been identified to clarify the requirements for noise terminology, assessment approaches, modelling methods and measurement procedures. The second section of changes are edits that seek to remove redundant information, clarify the requirements and improve the format of the rule so that it is consistent with other updated rules.
